COVID-19 update for Fairview Care family and visitors

The Ministry of Health have set the COVID-19 Protection Framework (traffic light), for all of New Zealand, at ORANGE.

This means we have made a few changes to our visiting restrictions as follows:

- Up to five designated visitors only (please advise Jemma or Mishelle on who the visitors will be in advance).
- Any visitors arriving at the hospital who are not on the list will not be able to enter.
- Visiting hours will remain between **1.00pm to 5.00pm Monday to Friday**; and **1.00pm to 4.00pm Saturday to Sunday**.
- Duration of visit is set at one hour.
- Please call or email Jemma and/or Mishelle to book your time: jemma@fairviewcare.co.nz & mishelle@fairviewcare.co.nz
- If you are able to take your family member out, we ask that you not to take them to overcrowded places, ensure they wear a mask and sanitize frequently.
- You can take your family member to the café/ restaurant upstairs on level 3.
- Negative RATs tests are still required for entering the care ward – please perform a test prior to arriving or we can do on site if needed.

With RSV and Flu season coming up, we are asking that young infants and children below the age of 12 not visit the facility over the winter months.
